1997 – Election of Life Member

In 1997 SACBA elected its first Life Member – *David Mitchell*



David received his Life Membership in recognition to his contribution to SA Country Baseball team, the SA Country Baseball Championship and the Broken Hill Association.

An extract from the booklet "The Golden Years of Baseball – 1937-1987 – the First 50 years at Broken Hill" shows the impact David had in Broken Hill baseball.

"The Golden Arm – there is no prizes for picking this one – it can only belong to David Mitchell. Baseball in Broken Hill is noted amongst other things of its broken-down pitchers, but even today, after 26 years of baseball, "Mitch" can still get the ball from third to first well before the runner, and if needed as a pitcher can keep a tight strike zone and make batters work hard for their hits. Not forgetting either, he can still hit the ball hard and is pretty good at running bases.

Well if he is that good now, how good was he in his "youth".

The newly formed Life Membership Committee gave the inaugural membership to David in honor of his outstanding 25 years service to South Australian Country Baseball.

When Norm Fox paid tribute to David in his historical book about Broken Hill Baseball "The Golden Years of Baseball 1937-1987 — The First Fifty Years at Broken Hill", his words were somewhat prophetic in retrospect. Norm headed a paragraph about David with the words "Golden Arm" and went on to say: "There are no prizes for picking this one — it can only belong to David Mitchell."

Ten years later David is still playing baseball at representative level as well as being a foundation member of the Broken hill

At the Adelaide presentation, the detailed history of David's baseball career painted the picture of a list of records few country baseballers could aspire to equal in their baseball career.

David started playing baseball at the age of 12, playing in the hot and dusty environs of Block 10. In the ensuing 39 years, he has seen many baseballs cross home plate.

The history of his baseball achievement include:

- * Life Member of the Broken Hill Baseball Association and the Redsox Baseball Club.
- * Won the Williams Medal for best and fairest in Broken Hill A Grade five times — a record held jointly with the legendary Graham Williams.
- * Chosen as a senior Broken Hill representative every year from 1965 through to 1997.
- * Member of every Bro-

ken Hill representative team which has contested the South Australian Country Championships since Broken Hill's entry in 1972.

* Member of the South Australian Country All Star side every year from 1972 until 1994. * Selected in every South Australian Country representative team which played in the Australian Commonwealth Baseball Series from 1972 until 1994. In 1992 a record of ten years attendance at the Commonwealth series was held jointly by David

and Mark Sweeney from the Victorian Provincial Team. The following year Mark was forced to withdraw.

In 1992 after achieving the unparalled records for 20 years as a Broken Hill representative at the South Australian Country Championships, ten years as a Country All Star representative and ten years as a South Australian Country representative at the Commonwealth baseball Series, he was presented with a silver tray by the Glenelg Baseball Club inscribed: "In recognition of 20 years to South Australian Country Baseball Championships 1972-1992 — Glenelg Baseball Club."

Five years later David has achieved the ultimate recognitions for a country baseballer. The Life Membership Award was clearly a popular one and the Broken Hill baseball team showed their recognition of their most senior as their most decorated players by standing as a body when the announcement was made.

Chippy awarded SA baseball life membership

Port Augusta baseball legend Chippy Haynes has been awarded life membership of the South Country Baseball Association

(SACBA).

A surprised Chippy received his award at the 1999 Country Championship at Glenelg Baseball Club grounds last month.

SACBA representative, David Mitchell, of Broken Hill, who was the first Life Member in 1997, presented Chippy with his badge and certificate and spoke highly of his record as a player, coach, umpire, SACBA president, as well as behind the scenes on the statistics staff.

Mr Mitchell said he was first introduced to

Mr Mitchell said he was first introduced to Chippy in 1972, during a Broken Hill versus

Millicent game.
"I was on second base and found Chippy friendly and chatty," he said.

"The conversation was very friendly from this old bloke and being a young fellow myself, I found

I lost a little concentration.
"I was about to move off the base and that's

"I was about to move off the base and that's when Chippy gave me a little push.

"The umpire saw I was tagged off the base – the hidden ball trick – and I was given out.

"Off the field he was a great guy, a popular person amongst the younger players he helped in the championship."

His dedication to the game was proven when, as an 'All Star Player' is 1070. Chippy along the same and the same player and the same player are the same and the same player.

an 'All Star Player', in 1970, Chippy played a match against the Glenelg A Grade after the Championship, which the Country All Stars won 5-3, with a painfully swollen and gashed knee, unbelkenum to his case. unbeknown to his coach.

After playing seven games against country and Northern Territory teams during the long weekend, to beat a leading baseball team like Glenelg was the icing on the cake.

Chippy's history reads like a legend, with his

baseball career starting in 1943.

He coached SA softball in Sydney at State level in 1950, and represented his State in 1954.

Before he left Adelaide, he played baseball for

Thebarton Technical Boy's School.

Along with the late Colin Taylor, he played winter baseball with the Goodwood Indians, as part of the SA Night Baseball League competition at Norwood Oval

When he married his long time girlfriend, Beryl Rhodes, a shift to the northern suburbs resulted in his transfer to Prospect Major A winter baseball team and Norths in the summer night baseball competition.

Following his retirement from the big league, Chippy played for the newly-formed Enfield club, e moving to the country in 1968.

His career continued with him forming the Millicent Baseball League, which comprised major A and B Grade teams, as well as three junior sides.

He also played for Mount Gambier and, in 1970, was the All Stars captain/coach and player for

In 1974, he was captain/coach of the Port Pirie team, made up of Port Augusta and Port Pirie players, which won the championship, and also All

Star coach in the same year.

In his later years of baseball, he took up umpiring for the October long weekend country championships, played at Glenelg Baseball Club grounds, and, since 1993, has been president of the South Australian Country Baseball Association.

Life membership is a fitting reward for Chippy's

outstanding history in country baseball.

Asked how he felt after the presentation, Chippy said he had only one regret.

"If I could swap the badge for one more year to make it 25 years of baseball in Port Augusta, it would have been a just reward," he said.

Vale Ken Wesslink – 14/4/1927 – 11/8/2016

Ken Wesslink was and always will be a Baseball legend and unique character; our sport will be poorer as a result of his passing. His passion was unrivalled and even in his 80's he kept that twinkle in his eye and never stopped learning about the game or the players.

Ken came to baseball from softball in 1955 and to his disappointment umpired his last baseball game in 2012 at nearly 85. Few individuals boast an active career spanning 57 years that impacted all levels of their chosen sport. His outstanding services to Baseball were recognised with Life Memberships of SACBA, SAJBL, SABL, BUASA, and an ultimate recognition by the ABF when awarded the ABF Presidents Award in 2008 for outstanding services to Baseball. Not to mention level 2 & 3 accreditations in coaching and umpiring.

Ken also acted (and was sought after) as Liaison / Executive Officer for Senior & Junior State, National or visiting International teams. Envied by their opposition, players and coaches appreciated the fresh sandwiches, fruit, lollies & drinks Ken organised for them on the bench. He was invited to the People's Republic of China to help coach and establish their national baseball program in 1985. Ken was also instrumental in establishing baseball in the Riverland and Murray Bridge and established many lines of communication with every regional centre.

It is no surprise that Ken had other interests for which he showed a similar passion and determination and one wonders where he found the time and energy particularly as he often worked 2-3 jobs to make ends meet until his eventual retirement from the workforce. Ken was an All Australian Softball umpire, a single handicap golfer, raced motorbikes and loved his flight simulator games, in particular the large units used in pilot training. Although having spent a number of trips with him in control of the Team bus I'm not sure I would want him at the controls of a plane.

Ken was a person of exceptional character and passion who rarely backed away from a fight and was always prepared to stand up and have his say. There are many administrators, players and coaches with happy and sometimes frustrating but always interesting tales & memories of Ken.

Unfortunately Ken's partner Vicky Tate (92) unexpectedly passed away the week prior to Ken. Vicky was a similar character and heavily involved in community activities. Perhaps she was taken early to prepare the afterlife for Ken's arrival.

Few will ever achieve the accolades and rewards that Ken has rec'd but Ken would be the first to tell you it had been the memories, friendships and successes that he cherished most. From a personal perspective our unlikely friendship developed from rocky beginnings but has endured over the last 27 years. Ken's friendship and our many conversations about baseball will be sorely missed but he will always be remembered.

"He took an outstanding catch and made a play which stopped Sunraysia in that innings.

"That was probably the only innings I felt uncomfortable where Sunraysia might have scored runs, but with

the catch it stopped the innings.
